

**Minutes of the Meeting of Norbury Parish Council
Held on 27th March 2024 at 7.00pm at Norbury Village Hall**

1 To receive any apologies for absence.

None received.

2 To record any Declarations of Interest.

There were no declarations of interest.

3 To receive the minutes last meeting of council, held on 28th February 2024

The minutes of the meeting were approved as a true and accurate record.

4 To consider any Matters Arising not covered elsewhere on the agenda

The two commemorative stone planters had been planted and placed in agreed locations. The Chair was thanked for overseeing this project.

War Memorial - a visual inspection had been carried out and it was agreed major maintenance is not necessary as there is no imminent risk of the wall falling. The wall would continued to be monitored .

It was agreed not to join Support Staffordshire for the forthcoming year.

5 To receive the Clerk's/Chairman's Report and any correspondence.

The Clerk informed Council that emails had been received from recipients of donations agreed at the last meeting. The Clerk suggested awarding a donation to First Responders in recognition of the regular inspections carried out on village defibrillators. It was agreed to donate £50.
